The Minnesota Pollution Control Agency staff (MPCA) has received your Petroleum Hydrocarbon Release Investigation and Corrective Action Design report dated July 1990, for the above referenced site. We understand that petroleum product thicknesses greater than 0.1 of one foot have been consistently detected on the ground water surface. It is the policy of the MPCA that if levels of free product greater than 0.1 foot are observed, preparations to begin a product recovery system should begin immediately and the recovery of free product should also begin as soon as possible. The MPCA does request that you notify the MPCA Tanks and Spills Section project manager of the design and installation of the product recovery system. However, do not wait to start the recovery system. It is crucial to begin free product recovery as soon as possible.

Based on the information presented in your report, the MPCA staff has been hereby notified of the design of the product recovery system and is requiring that the installation of the system begin immediately. It is the duty of the responsible person to recover as rapidly and as thoroughly as possible to minimize or abate pollution of waters of the state Minn. Stat. §115.061.

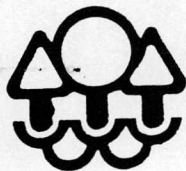
The MPCA has prioritized your report and will provide comments and/or Corrective Action Design approval based on the results of our complete review.
