Any and all Data from January 1, 2000 to the date of this request between the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency ("MPCA") staff, agents or employees and the United States Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA") regarding the presence, production, release, monitoring, testing or reports for landfill gas or any of its typical constituents from, at or emanating from the Properties, including, without limitation, and Remedial Investigations in the possession of MPCA which were provided to EPA; and
- Any and all Data as it relates to any public statements of Mr. Pat Hanson made to any elected officials of Burnsville regarding the presence or absence of any releases of hazardous substances, pollutants or contaminants as those terms are defined in Minn. Stat. 115B.02 (collectively "Hazardous Substances") to the limestone beneath the Properties; and
- 3. Any and all recordings or transcripts of the meeting between MPCA staff, agents or employees and the City of Burnsville on or about July 8, 2019; and
- 4. Any and all correspondence, transmittals or evidence showing that the MPCA every sent, disseminated or transferred originals or copies of any Environmental Impact
