On October 7, 2005, the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency (MPCA) staff issued a letter of approval for land treatment of petroleum contaminated soil from the site referenced above. The approval letter specified that additional follow-up soil analysis is required at the land treatment site in accordance with Minn. R. pt. 7037.2700.

The MPCA staff has received and reviewed the monitoring results for soil samples collected at the land treatment site on October 24, 2006. The results indicate that the soil has been adequately treated. Therefore, no further follow-up soil monitoring and tillage is required at the land treatment site.
