Dear John:

On behalf of our client, Waste Management, Inc., we are submitting an application to treat approximately 100 cubic yards of petroleum contaminated soil at the C.S. McCrossan/CMI asphalt plant located in Maple Grove, MN. The CMI plant is on the Agency's list of NSPS asphalt plants authorized to roast soil as of April 24, 1989.

The contaminated soil is currently stockpiled at Waste Management's Savage facility pending agency approval of the enclosed permit application.

A copy of the laboratory analysis is being provided for easy reference, however, additional supportive documentation can be found in the investigative report entitled "Petroleum Tank Release Corrective Action Report", previously submitted and on file with the agency.

A letter from C.S. McCrossan Construction, dated 6/14/89, stating that their asphalt plant has been properly maintained and/or repaired and is capable of operating in compliance with MPCA rules and regulations, is also attached.
