Dear Mr. Nickelson:

The Minnesota Pollution Control Agency (MPCA) has been informed that a flood-related release of petroleum has occurred from a storage tank or tanks which you own and/or operate. Flood-related releases include: tank overflows caused by entering flood waters, tank floatation/buoyancy, and other tank system destruction caused by flood waters. We are aware that you may have been previously contacted by MPCA staff or contractors, and that your cleanup efforts may already be complete. Now that flood waters have subsided, we wanted to initiate correspondence with you to inform you of your MPCA contact if clean up is still in progress, or if other tank related complications should arise.

In addition, you may be eligible for Petrofund reimbursement for your tank cleanup expenses. Those persons who have taken corrective actions in flood related tank releases may be eligible for reimbursement for a major portion of the costs of corrective action. The legislature has established a fund known as the Petrofund (Petroleum Tank Release Cleanup Account) to reimburse responsible persons and volunteers. The account is administered by the Petro Board which is part of the Minnesota Department of Commerce. The above leak number and enclosed Petrofund application will be necessary to initiate the reimbursement process. Please refer to the enclosed fact sheet for eligibility and other information.

If you have any questions concerning this letter or need additional information, please contact me at 612/297-8583. Please reference the above LEAK # in all correspondence. If you are calling long distance, you may reach the MPCA St. Paul office by calling 1/800-657-3864. If we do not hear from you within 30 days, we will assume your clean up has been completed, and will close your file at that time. Be advised that, if eligible, you may apply for Petrofund reimbursement at any time.
