Sandy,

I have reviewed the aforementioned report and have the following comments and recommendations:

COMMENTS

- GW flow has been determined to be to the southeast. There is no down-gradient well, but the source area is attenuating and only GRO and DRO exceed action levels, but not by much. I'm not going to recommend a down-gradient well be installed based on the data. I talked to Mark Millsop and Ryan Rupp today. Mark was uncertain about the on-site well, so he suggested I call Ryan. Ryan said the old well was being sealed yesterday and today a new well was going in. Ryan recommended to the Band that they not install a new well, but they wanted one anyway. They are aware of the contamination at the site, and the new well is being put in further from the contamination. I told Ryan I would request a copy of the sealing record, a copy of the new well record, and an updated figure with the location of the new well prior to considering closure.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Adam's Recommendations:

Through a phone conversation with Ryan Rupp, MPCA staff was informed that the on-site water supply well was being abandoned and a new well was being installed. Prior to considering site closure, the MPCA requests a copy of the Minnesota Department of Health (MDH) *Well and Boring Sealing Record* for the old on-site well, a copy of the MDH *Well and Boring Record* for the new on-site well, and an updated site diagram that shows the location of the new ^{well}. Please submit the requested items within 90 days from the date of this letter.
