On August 21, 1990, the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency (MPCA) staff mailed you a corrective action approval letter outlining work completed for your "new" gasoline release and discussing work to be completed for the "older" release. As of September 6, 1991, the MPCA has not received information defining the magnitude and extent of the "older" petroleum release.

Based on the conclusions and recommendations provided by your consultant, additional work is necessary at your site to define the magnitude and extent of petroleum contamination. Please have your consultant proceed with the remedial investigation (RI) following the appropriate MPCA technical documents. When the RI phase is completed, please have your consultant submit a report following the MPCA "Petroleum Tank Release Investigation Report" (PTR). This report should summarize the RI and propose either a corrective action design to complete the cleanup or recommend and justify that no further action is necessary. A copy of the PTR document was included with the initial letter and packet of information you received from the MPCA regarding the petroleum release at your site.
