SUBJECT: Dittmer Oil, Fairfax, MN Leak #1940

Mark, as we discussed on the telephone today, here is the list of things we need to determine cleanup goals for the Dittmer Oil site:

- --Complete the ground water receptor survey by considering the residences north of the site.
- --Provide a map showing the project boring locations with respect to the nearby properties and drinking water wells.
- --Install a monitoring well at approximately the location of either boring B-6 or B-7. Pump the elevator well and measure at this (and possibly other existing monitoring wells) for influence of the water table.
- -- Provide sample dates, extracation and analysis dates for values in Table 4.
- --This information should be sufficient to allow us to determine whether the site is a low risk setting needing no further corrective action. We will set cleanup goals upon receipt of the above information.
