The Minnesota Pollution Control Agency (MPCA) staff is requesting an update on the above-referenced site. On September 9, 1991, MPCA staff mailed a request for additional work at your site to define the extent and magnitude of petroleum contamination. Since that date, we have not received any response from you concerning the requested Remedial Investigation and Corrective Action Design (RI/CAD) report.

If you do perform the requested work, the state may reimburse you for a major portion of your costs. The Petroleum Tank Release Cleanup Act establishes a fund which in certain circumstances provides partial reimbursement for petroleum tank release cleanup costs. This fund is administered by the Petroleum Tank Release Compensation Board (Petro Board). More specific eligibility rules are available from the Petro Board (612/297-4017).

We look forward to receiving the RI/CAD or an update on the progress of work at your site.
