On August 13, 1990, the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency (MPCA) issued a letter of approval for land treatment of petroleum contaminated soil excavated from the site referenced above. The approval letter specified that additional follow-up monitoring of the land treated soil is required at the land treatment site.

The MPCA staff has received and reviewed the monitoring results for soil samples collected at the land treatment site. The results indicate that the soil has been adequately treated. Therefore, no further follow-up soil monitoring and tillage is required for this soil.
