The Minnesota Pollution Control Agency (MPCA) Site Remediation and Redevelopment Program seeks your cooperation in the investigation and cleanup of a solvent release at the Former Dry Cleaners – Rochester #3 Site (a.k.a. Minnesota BioBusiness Center), located at 221 1st Avenue SW, Rochester. Most recently, Landmark Environmental LLC, the Consultant for the City of Rochester, has been working toward completion of the investigation and cleanup, and which has included several years of groundwater pump and treatment to remove tetrachloroethylene (PCE). The groundwater contamination appears to be migrating to the southwest of the site at concentrations above health risk limits established by the Minnesota Department of Health, and the two Franklin Heating Plant production wells appear as potential receptors.

The MPCA requests your cooperation in the completion of the attached Access Agreement and providing for a representative of Landmark Environmental to collect a round of well water grab samples.
