RE: Approval for Thermal Treatment of Petroleum Contaminated Soil Site: Sinclair Station, 7753 Portland Avenue South, Richfield

Your application dated June 8, 1990, for treatment of 300 cubic yards of petroleum contaminated soil from the above site is hereby approved by staff of the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency (MPCA) subject to the following conditions.

Soils will be treated by CleanSoils, Inc. Air Quality permit number 2307-90-0T-1.

2. Protection from run-on, infiltration and run-off shall be provided for contaminated soils stored prior to treatment.

Soil treatment will be completed by July 31, 1990.

MPCA staff must be notified of the proposed date of the soil treatment prior to the actual treatment date. Please notify Bob Dullinger of the proposed treatment date.

Treated soils shall be incorporated into asphalt, used as road base, or utilized as controlled fill.

Within 30 days of soil treatment, MPCA staff shall be provided with a site summary including the MPCA Site ID number, date soil treatment was completed, the volume of contaminated soil processed, post-burn analyses, and final disposition of the processed soil.

Failure to comply with the conditions of this approval may result in enforcement actions against either the generator of the contaminated soil or the facility operators or both. Failure to comply may also result in refusal by the MPCA to approve of similar applications for contaminated soil treatment by the facility or generator in the future.
