The Minnesota Pollution Control Agency (MPCA) staff has reviewed the data provided by you in a report dated January 3, 1991, for the above-referenced site. The work performed at the site conformed to the guidelines established by the state Fire Marshal and the MPCA for underground storage tank removal and abandonment. Based on Delta's conclusion that no leak occurred, the MPCA staff will not require additional investigation or corrective action at this time.

The MPCA staff reserves the right to reopen this file and require additional work if in the future more work is determined by us to be necessary. Further, this letter does not release any party from liability for contamination which may actually be present at this site. If you, or other parties later come upon any evidence of greater levels of contamination than have already been reported, you are required to notify MPCA.
